

2022 McDonalds State Track & Field Centre Duties SATURDAY 19TH & SUNDAY 20th OF MARCH

Thank you for assisting LANSW in hosting the McDonalds 2022 State Track and Field Championships at Sydney Olympic Park. The centre helpers who assist the officials are a vital component to the success of the event.

This year, we are completing the allocation slightly differently by utilising an online program. This program allows the individual or centre to select the specific event that they wish to help with. The online sign up does operate on a **first in first served basis**.

The allocation numbers are based on 'slots' this year rather than entire area. For example, rather than Shot Put, it is now U9 GIRLS, U10 BOYS etc Shot Put. This change has resulted in what appears to be a spike in the number of centre helpers. But the number of centre helpers is similar to previous years, we have just broken down the allocations.

The sign up is divided into the following:

- Equipment (Saturday and Sunday)
- Saturday Administrations (includes, call room)
- Saturday Field
- Saturday Track
- Sunday Administrations (includes call room and medals)
- Sunday Field
- Sunday Track

Ideally, individual centre helpers complete the online sign up, however if the centre would prefer to, they can do it on behalf of the centre helpers, simply using the centre name as the first name.

THE PROCESS

- 1. LANSW informs the Centres of their number of allocations (see below).
- Centres are then able to sign up on behalf of their Centre through the link below OR the link is shared to parents to sign up themselves. All duties for each centre must be completed by 16th March.

PLEASE NOTE

Centres are to be reminded that their Team Manager will be contacted if their centre is not fulfilling their duties. If there is no team manager, parents may be called.

Consideration has been given to the number of qualifiers from each centre when allocating duties.

All finish times are approximate only and helpers will be expected to stay at their duty until they are replaced, or their allocated events are completed.

Relay duties are to be treated as separate to the other allocations (they are only needed for an hour or less). It is suggested that centres with teams in the relays be asked to supply helpers - 1 helper if the centre has 1 or 2 teams; 2 if the centre has 3 or 4 teams.

SAFETY

Helpers are to be reminded that for safety reasons it is recommended that they wear



enclosed shoes, not thongs or loose sandals, especially on throws events. If anyone turns up without closed in shoes, they will still be required to assist, but will be moved to another area.

SUNSAFE

Helpers are reminded to be 'sun safe'. They should set an example to the athletes by wearing appropriate clothing and hats, regularly applying sunscreen and hydrating.

Little Athletics NSW will attempt to provide sunscreen that can be used by the athletes as well as officials.
